

Domestic Violence Advocate Core Training: Getting Started

About this Course

This 35-hour course is a comprehensive introductory domestic violence training intended to fill the statutory requirement for victim advocates (<u>Rule 505.5</u> of the Hawai'i Revised Statutes).

Getting Started



Course Navigation

MENU GLOSSARY

Navigating the course is easy. On the left side of the screen, you'll see a **menu**. This is how you can track your progress through the lessons. Expand this menu, by clicking \equiv .



In the lower right corner, you will see the **previous and next buttons**. You can go back to previous content at any time. Sometimes the content will progress automatically. Other times you'll have to advance by clicking the next button. The navigation is tied to the narration. So please be sure to let the narration finish before you try to navigate forward or to the previous content.



If you need to stop and resume the course later, click the **Exit Course button** in the upper right corner of the screen. Your progress will be saved and you won't need to repeat any content.



Lessons may include **additional resources** for you to further your knowledge. You can access these within Coalition Manager. You will need to download and view each resource before you can proceed to the next lesson.



Key terms are included in a **Glossary** for each lesson. You can access them by clicking the Glossary tab in the menu bar.
